

Questions you can ask for a personality profile:

- What do you want to do after you graduate high school?
- Where have you worked?
- What honors/awards have you received?
- Could you give some personal background about your life?
- Are you involved in any community organizations (charities, church, etc.)?
- What are your hobbies?
- Where did you grow up? Did you move around a lot? If yes, how did this affect you? If no, how did the stability of living in one place all your life affect you?
- Are there any political or social issues you feel passionately about?
- List your favorites (book, movie or play, quote, poem, website, type of food or individual dish, music genre, song, band or individual musician, perfume, clothing style or designer, etc.).
- Where have you traveled?
- What are your greatest stresses and what causes you the most anxiety in your life?
- What is most rewarding thing about your life right now?
- What's the hardest thing for you about being a teenager? How do you address that?
- So far what's been your most embarrassing moment in life?
- Favorite weekend activity?
- What's your favorite funny story about yourself?
- List three misconceptions that people often have about you (and, if none, why).
- What was your favorite toy (or game) as a child, and why?

- What makes you laugh?
- Who has been a big influence in your life? Why are they such an influence on you?
- If you had to name a defining moment in your life so far, what would it be and why?
- Best compliment you've ever received?
- Name one thing about yourself that most people don't know.
- Anything else you'd like to add?
